

# Tofutsies Crochet Socks

## Materials

1 ball SWTC Tofutsies  
Crochet hook size E/4-3.50mm  
Large eyed blunt needle

**Size** to fit ladies' size 7

**Gauge** 28 sts X 32 rows = 4" in sc

## Stitches:

**Dsc** (double single crochet) – in indicated st, insert hook and pull up one loop, yo and pull through one loop on hook, yo and pull through both loops on hook.

**Fpdc** (front post double crochet) - work a double crochet around post of indicated stitch (inserting hook from front to back)

**Bpdc** (back post double crochet) - yo, work a double crochet around post of indicated stitch (inserting hook from back to front)

**Note:** The pattern is first worked from the top down, leaving an opening for the heel which is added later.

## Begin:

Rnd 1 Ch 122, dc into 5th ch from hook. \*Skip 1 ch, dc in next ch\* around. Do not join, and being careful not to twist, bring end of rnd just made around to work the next st into the first st of rnd 1.

Rnds 2-16 \*Fpdc around next 2 sts, Bpdc around next st\* around (Do not join rounds. Use a stitch marker to indicate beginning of each round.)

Rnd 17 (Fpdc around next 2 sts, Bpdc around next st) 12 times. Next you'll create the opening for the heel: ch 2, dsc in ch, (dsc in ch created in middle of previous dsc) 23 times. Skip last 24 sts of Rnd.

Rnds 18-21 Continue in post stitch pattern as established along top of sock, then dsc in each dsc along bottom of sock

Rnd 22 Continue in post stitch pattern along top, then sc2tog, dsc across to within last 2 sts, sc2tog along bottom

Rnd 23 Continue in post stitch pattern along top, dsc in each st along bottom

Rnd 24 Continue in post stitch pattern along top, then sc2tog, dsc across to within last 2 sts, sc2tog along bottom

Rnd 25 Continue in post stitch pattern along top, dsc in each st along bottom

Rnds 26-27 Continue in post stitch pattern along top, then sc2tog, dsc across to within last 2 sts along bottom, sc2tog

Rnds 28-42 Work evenly in pattern

Rnds 43-48 Sc across top, working along bottom sc2tog, sc across to within last 2 sts, sc2tog.

Fasten off leaving long tail. Turn inside out and use tail to sew up toe.



## Heel

Attach with a sc to any st in the corner of heel opening.

Rnd 1 Sc evenly around working 2 sc in each corner of heel. Slip st to first sc

Rnd 2 Ch 1, work sc evenly around working sc2tog twice at each corner of heel. Slip st to first sc.

Repeat Rnd 2 until heel opening is 1 inch long. Fasten off leaving long tail. Turn sock inside out, flatten out heel and use tail to whipstitch close.

## Cabled Ribbing

Rnd 1 Attach with a fpdc in any fpdc around top of sock.

Fpdc in each fpdc around skipping all bpdc. Do not join, use a scrap piece of yarn to indicate first st of each round.

Rnd 2 \*Skip next st, fpdc in following st, fpdc in skipped st.

Fpdc 2 \* Repeat from \* to \* around

Rnd 3 \*Fpdc 2, Skip next st, fpdc in following st, fpdc in skipped st. \* R Repeat from \* to \* around

Rnd 4-5 Repeat Rnds 2-3

Rnd 6 Fpdc in each st around. Slip st to first st. Fasten off.
