



**Stringtown's  
Tofutsies  
Baby Blanket**

*Using at least 2 skeins of SWTC Tofutsies sock yarn held together, this blanket is the perfect opportunity to experiment with the wonderful colors of this great yarn. Use two skeins of the same color or mix it up by using two different colors. You can even switch between several different colors (use up those leftovers!) for a gradual color change effect.*

**Materials:**

SWTC Tofutsies , 2 skeins  
US 9 Circular Needle, 24 inch  
Needle to weave in ends

**Gauge:** Approx. 4 stitches per inch.

**Finished Size:** 20x 30 (Perfect for a stroller or carseat!)

**Notes:**

If you want a larger blanket, you'll need more yarn, and if you want it to be more than 30in wide, you'll need to cast on more than 120 stitches. Just be sure to increase your number of stitches cast on in multiples of 4 and you'll be OK.

**Pattern:**

Cast on 120 stitches

Knit 12 rows, then begin the center ribbing pattern as follows:

Row 1: K4, \*K2, P2\* across, K4

Row 2: Repeat Row 1

Row 3: Knit all the way across

Repeat those three rows until your blanket is 18 inches long (or until it's almost as long as you want it if you're making a larger size)

Knit 12 rows

Bind off being careful not to bind off too tightly

**Finish:**

Weave in the ends and machine wash with cold water on the delicate cycle. Tumble dry on low or delicate.
